When someone pretends to be another person online by using **fake pictures** or **made-up details**. They do this to trick others into thinking they are friends or in a relationship. Often, the person has bad intentions, like trying to steal **money, images** or **hurt someone's feelings**.

How would you know if someone isn't being honest about their identity online?







What to do if you think you're being catfished...







Don't send anything that makes you feel uncomfortable

Check their photos with Google's Reverse Image Search

Screenshot, block and report



What to do if you think you're being catfished...



Talk to someone – a problem shared is a problem halved!



If you are in danger, call the police for help on 999.



You are not alone, always talk to one of your trusted adults if something is bothering you.
