If you need help or support with anything, this is how you can go about getting some help:

- 1. Email or googleclassroom your form teacher when you get home;
- 2. Talk to the classroom assistant who works with your class if you need help during the school day;
- 3. Talk to any of your subject teachers, especially if your problem is about your work;
- 4. Ask a parent/guardian to email your form teacher for you.
